

DEPLOY TO CLOUDFLARE

Your Pre-Flight Checklist

PRE-FLIGHT CHECK

- Widget built and working locally?
- Specs documented? (you know what it SHOULD do)
- Must-dos tested? (each one checked off)
- Files saved? (you know where your index.html is)

DEPLOY: STEP BY STEP

STEP 1: Go to cloudflare.com and log in (free account)

STEP 2: In the left sidebar, click "Workers & Pages"

STEP 3: Click "Create" then "Pages"

STEP 4: Choose "Direct Upload"

STEP 5: Name your project (lowercase, no spaces)

Your URL becomes: your-project-name.pages.dev

STEP 6: Drag your widget files into the upload area

STEP 7: Click "Deploy"

STEP 8: YOUR WIDGET IS LIVE ON THE INTERNET!

THE ASSUMPTION TRAP

Claude says it's done. Is it? GO TO YOUR LIVE URL AND:

- Does the page load?
- Do all the colors/fonts look right?
- Click every button. Do they work?
- Fill out every form field. Does it submit?
- Try it on your phone. Does it look good?
- Try submitting garbage. What happens?

"I asked for it" does NOT mean "it happened right."

"Claude says it works" does NOT mean "it works for humans."

If a human hasn't clicked every button, it's not tested.

MAKING CHANGES AFTER DEPLOY

Fix it in Claude → Save files → Cloudflare → Create new deployment → Upload → Deploy → Refresh. Changes are instant.

Cost of hosting: \$0. Cost of SSL: \$0. Cost of excuses: expired.

"You built it. You shipped it. You tested it. You're a builder now."
